POSITION SUMMARY

Obtain criminal background reports for applicants to Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher Program and disseminate information to program staff. Assist the Security Coordinator with management and coordination of THA's Community Enhancement Unit, third party security contractors, and oversight of the security of THA property, residents, and staff.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Obtain criminal background reports on THA applicants, residents and employees from a computerized data system and disseminate information to appropriate housing staff to ensure compliance with THA policies.
- Train property management staff compliance on criminal background policies and procedures and monitor compliance.
- Assist with monitoring reported fraud and drug activity that is submitted

through THA's website, TulsaHousing.org.

- Ensure that the information is forwarded to the correct individuals: Tulsa Police Department, THA's Community Enhancement Unit, or housing staff.
- Track reported fraud and drug activity in a log and follow up to ensure that reported fraud and drug activity was addressed.
- Support Security Coordinator in working with THA's Community Enhancement Unit and third-party private security contractors.
- Assist with oversight of THA's security cameras. Monitor and log weekly that every security camera is working at each THA location.
- Assist with weekly Domestic Violence classes held at THA's Central Office.
- File THA's court paperwork accurately and timely with the Tulsa County Courthouse.
- Appear and testify as a witness in court trials if required.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
