Important Message Re: May Rent Payments

Your health, safety and well-being are the top priority for all of us at the Housing Authority of the City of Tulsa (THA). We know that things are challenging right now for so many, and particularly many of our residents. We want to ensure that you and your families have all that you need to remain healthy physically, emotionally and financially.

To help ease some of the financial burden for you during this time, we are waiving rent for the month of May for residents of THA public housing properties and Project-Based Rental Assistance (PBRA) properties. This includes residents of Apache Manor, Comanche Park, East Central Village, Hewgley Terrace, Inhofe Plaza, LaFortune Tower, The Meadows, Mohawk Manor, Murdock Villa, Parkview Terrace, Pioneer Plaza, Riverview Park, Sandy Park, Seminole Hills/Whitlow, South Haven Manor, Scattered Sites and Towne Square.

We hope that this helps you and your family commit your financial resources to other needs you may have as we face the situation surrounding the coronavirus (COVID-19) together as a community.

Please keep the information we are sharing with you related to THA's response to COVID-19 so you will have phone numbers that you may need readily available.

As a reminder, our central office (415 E. Independence St.) is closed through at least April 30. During this closure, please call your property manager, social service coordinator or our main phone line (918-582-0021) with questions or concerns. Our staff is also still available via email.
